We have discussed with the students the privilege of loaning senior books and the expectation of a mature response to reading these. Library staff consistently communicate with our teachers to ensure students are borrowing books appropriate to their reading and comprehension levels. However, we ask that you advise us if you prefer your child to refrain from borrowing books from this area.
