### **ST PATRICK'S FEAST DAY**

On Thursday March 17, we will be celebrating St Patrick's Feast Day. This is a special feast day in the Church's liturgical calendar as it recognises a man who became a Christian in his teenage years and then spent his life preaching the Good News of God. To celebrate this day, we are asking students to come dressed in green. They will still be required to wear appropriate closed-in shoes. This is not a fundraising day, simply a day for the students to have a little fun dressing in green and supporting the ideals of St Patrick.

### **BEFORE SCHOOL PROCESS AND SUPERVISION**
